Scripture prayers to pray over America as we celebrate our freedom to worship in this great land!

Father, we do not cease to give thanks for America, remembering America in our prayers. I always pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may grant America a spirit of wisdom and of revelation that gives America a deep, personal, and intimate insight into the true knowledge of Christ, for America knows the Father through the Son.

And I pray that the eyes of America's heart, the very center and core of America's being may be enlightened and flooded with light by the Holy Spirit, so that America will know and cherish the hope, the divine guarantee, the confident expectation, to which Jesus Christ has called America, the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints, God's people of America.

And so that America will begin to know what the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His active, spiritual power is in Americans who believe. These are in accordance with the working of His mighty strength which He produced in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His own right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion whether angelic or human, and far above every name that is named above every title that can be conferred, not only in this age and world but also in the one to come.

And He put all things in every realm in subjection under Christ's feet, and appointed Him as supreme and authoritative head over all things in the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills and completes all things in all American believers in Jesus name! (Ephesians 1:16-23)

Father, Your word states that when the priests came out of the Holy Place for all the priests who were present had sanctified themselves, separating themselves from everything unclean. And when in unison we worshipers make our voices heard with one voice praising and thanking You, Lord, and when we raise our voices accompanied by the trumpets and cymbals and other instruments of music, and when we praise the Lord, saying, "For He is good, for His mercy and loving kindness endure forever, then this house of the Lord is filled with a cloud of glory so that the priests (all of America's kings and priests) can not remain standing to minister because of the glory cloud, for the glory and brilliance of the Lord fills this house of God!

We join in the same Spirit of God as Solomon as he dedicated the temple to You, Lord. The Lord has said that He would dwell in the thick cloud. We have built You a lofty house, a place for You to dwell forever. Dwell in this great land we call America, Lord. Dwell within our borders, Father. Dwell in Your houses of worship across this great land! We ask this in agreement with Your Word and Your Spirit, in Jesus Name, Amen. (II Chron. 5:11, 13-14, II Chron. 6:1)

Then Solomon stood before the altar of the Lord in the presence of the entire assembly, and we stand before You, O Lord, over this great land of America and we spread out of hands as Solomon did. For

Solomon had made a bronze platform, five cubits square and three cubits high, and had set it in the midst of the courtyard; and he stood on it, and he knelt down on his knees in the presence of all the assembly and spread out his hands toward heaven, and we do the same today in America, Father and we say as Solomon said.

O Lord, God of America, there is no god like You in heaven or on the earth, keeping covenant and showing mercy and loving kindness to Your servants who walk before You in obedience with all our hearts, and You who have kept Your promises to us in America, You have spoken with Your mouth and have fulfilled it with Your hand, as it is today. Now therefore, O Lord, the God of America, keep with us that which you kept with our forefathers as You promised them, so shall Your promises continue to be fulfilled here. You shall not fail to have a man to sit on the throne of America, provided our sons are careful to walk in Your law as others have walked before God. Now then, O Lord, the God of America, let Your word which You have spoken be confirmed, and verified.

But will God actually dwell with mankind on the earth? Behold, heaven and the highest heaven cannot contain You; how much less this house which human hands have built! Yet have regard for the prayer of Your servants for our supplication, O Lord, our God, to listen to the cry and to the prayer which Your servants pray before You today, that Your eyes may be open toward this house day and night, toward the place in which You have said that You would put Your Name and Presence to listen to the prayer which Your servants shall pray. So listen to the requests of Your servants and Your people of America. Hear from Your dwelling place, from heaven; and when You hear, forgive.

If a man sins against his neighbor, and he is required to take an oath, and he comes and takes the oath before Your altar, then hear from heaven and act and judge Your servants, punishing the wicked by bringing his conduct on his own head, and providing justice to the righteous by giving to him in accordance with his righteousness and innocence. If Your people of America have been defeated by an enemy because we have sinned against You, and we return to You and confess Your Name, and pray and make supplication before You in this house, then hear from heaven and forgive the sin of Your American people, and bring them again to the land of promise which You have given to us and to our fathers.

When the heavens are shut up and there is no rain because the American people have sinned against you, and we pray toward this place and confess Your Name, and turn from our sin when You afflict and humble us, then hear in heaven and forgive the sin of America, indeed, teach us the good way in which we should walk. And send rain on Your land, which You have given to us as an inheritance. If there is famine in the land, if there is pestilence, if there is blight or mildew, if there is migratory locusts or grasshoppers, if our enemies besiege us in the land of our cities, whatever plague or whatever sickness there is, then whatever prayer or request is made by any man or all of Your people in America, each knowing his own suffering and his own pain, and stretching out his hands toward Your presence, then hear from heaven, Your dwelling place, and forgive, and render to each in accordance with all his ways, whose hearts You know; for You alone know the hearts of the sons of men, so that we may fear You, to walk in Your ways in obedience to You as long as we live in the land which You have given to our fathers and to us.

Also in regard to the foreigner who is not from America, but has come from a far country for the sake of Your great Name and Your mighty power and Your outstretched arm- when they come and pray toward this house, then hear from heaven, from Your dwelling place, and do according to all for which the foreigner calls to You, so that all the people may know Your name, and fear You, reverently and

worshipfully, as do Your American people, and that they may know that this nation, is called by Your Name.

When America goes out to war against our enemies, by the way that You send us, and we pray to You, then hear from heaven our prayers and our requests, and maintain our causes to do justice. When we sin against You, for there is no man who does not sin, and You are angry with us and hand us over to an enemy, so that they take us away captive to a land far away or near, if America takes it to our hearts in the land where we have been taken captive, and repent and pray to You in the land of our captivity, saying, "We have sinned, we have done wrong and have acted wickedly." When we return to You with all our hearts and with all our souls in the land of our captivity, and pray facing Your throne and Your presence, then hear from heaven, from Your dwelling place, our prayer and requests, and maintain our cause and do justice and forgive Your people of America who have sinned against You.

Now, O my God, I pray, let Your eyes be open and Your ears attentive to the prayer offered in this nation. Now then arise, O Lord God, and come to Your resting place, You and the ark of Your strength and power. Let Your priests, O Lord God, be clothed with salvation and let Your godly ones rejoice in Your goodness.

O Lord, God, do not turn away and reject the face of Your anointed; remember Your loving kindness and faithfulness to Your people of America. (II Chron. 6:12-42)

On this great day of the year when we celebrate our freedom to worship You, we humbly ask You to bless Your people, Lord. Bless this nation, Father. We adore You as we stand in the gap for all the American people in Jesus mighty name, Amen!
